While summarizing our activities for the main target, young people, we understood that there is a set of activities offered for them:

- 1) **Youth Information** – information about one´s possibilities leads to towards conscious steps in the future. We are sharing information not only in our web and monthly e-newsletter, but also in public events and school information sessions all around Estonia together with Eurodesk and NIP – Youth Information Portal (www.nip.ee). We are not only `the producers`, but also sharing our partners´ information.
- 2) **International Projects** – those have been one of the most successful due to client interests and feedback. Giving access to train oneself up to chilling in the non-formal atmosphere together with other young people from all over Europe and for a very reasonable price. Usually supported by the Youth Programme/ Youth in Action Programme.
- 3) **Multicultural Evenings *European Club*** – held throughout a year and giving youngsters possibility to share their emotions and knowledge for the others interested in foreign cultures.
- 4) **Trainings *Young Project Management School*** – trainings in collaboration with Eurodesk aimed at young people and held in Tallinn, Tartu, Pärnu and Viljandi for project management skills – necessary tool in many work positions.
- 5) **Voluntary Service** – we are not only working with European Voluntary Service as a sending organisation, but also as a hosting organisation. Collaborating with other organisations in Estonia in order to promote EVS more as well. Currently sharing information about volunteerism, and including some active youngsters to our activities.
- 6) **Local Projects and Campaigns** – EURO<26 Estonia is collaborating with many organisations in order to implement other local activities and campaigns. For instance, we are working together with Estonian National Youth Council and campaign `All Different, All Equal` coordinated by Estonian Youth Work Centre for International Youth Day - 12th August 2007.
- 7) **Discounts** – at the very moment we have 88 discount places for the cardholders – for classical and two kinds of co-brand cards, and of course for cardholders from all EYCA family! We promise that the number is increasing every month!
